Emergency Tip of the Month

Earlier this week, a brush fire occurred in North County area of San Diego that spread over 12 acres. The fire was extinguished with no threat to structures, but this is an excellent time to review basic preparedness techniques in case of a more serious wild fire.

Here are 4 tips on how your child care program can be prepared in case of a wild fire.

1. Register your mobile phones with Alert San Diego by logging on to www.readysandiego.org/alertsandiego.
2. Make sure emergency cards are up to date including current parent phone numbers, e-mail addresses, Facebook or twitter accounts
3. Inform parents of your potential evacuation location
4. Determine how children will be transported out of the area if the wildfire is approaching your child care

Remember that Daylight Savings Time ends on Sunday, November 6. While changing your clocks back one hour, remember to also change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
